



## Field of Interest Fund

Connecting personal values to high  
impact opportunities



**By establishing a Field of Interest Fund**, you may target your gift to address needs in an important area of community life, such as the arts, the environment, or education. The Albuquerque Community Foundation awards grants to community organizations and programs that are making a difference in the area you select. Your gift stays flexible enough to meet community needs in your interest area even as those specific needs change over time.

### How it works

You identify an area of personal interest as broad or narrow as you wish.

You make a gift to the Foundation during your lifetime or through a bequest. You may give cash, appreciated stock, real estate, or other assets.

We establish a fund in your name, in the name of your family or business, or in honor of any person or organization you choose.

Your fund is pooled with the Foundation's other endowment funds and invested. Over time, earnings are used to make grants addressing community needs. Your gift, and all future earnings, are a permanent source of community capital, helping to accomplish good work forever.

We handle all the administrative details.

You receive tax benefits for the year your gift is made.

A Field of Interest fund begins with a \$10,000 contribution, which can be made at one time or grown over 3 years.

### A personal mission

The Nathan Wineberg Endowment for Senior Arts was created specifically to benefit seniors at Highland and Bear Canyon Senior Centers. Coordinators at each center arrange workshops attended by 750 seniors, including hula, tango, Ukrainian egg dyeing, drawing, papel picado, vocal harmonizing, and ceramics.
